- Funded by private US citizens
- Supplied the Hungarian Red Cross with over 200 metric tons of food for distribution to needy individuals and families in 2010
- Launched five joint programs with the Hungarian Red Cross in 2010

School Breakfast and Snack Program



Supplied a total of 9 million Ft worth of bread, meat, cheese, vegetables and fruit to five elementary schools twice a week.



Supplied a total of 1 million Ft worth of bread, meat, cheese, fruit, vegetables and orange juice to school children in the form of week-end food parcels on a weekly basis.

Supplementary Feeding Program

 Delivered a total of 9.5 million Ft worth of bread, meat, vegetables, fruit, cheese and other milk products to Hungarian Red Cross operated homeless shelters for distribution to shelter residents twice a week.









Monthly Food Aid Program

 Supplied a total of 1.2 million Ft worth of milk, flour, wheat meal, rice, eating oil, lentils and canned meat to 8th and 9th district Red Cross offices for distribution to 120 families on a monthly basis.











Daily Food Aid Program

 Delivered 23 million Ft worth of bread and milk to the Jasz-Nagykun-Szolnok chapter of the Hungarian Red Cross for twice weekly distribution to 200 impoverished families.









Shelter Improvement Program



Old Csepel Men's Shelter

 Contributed 42.4 million Ft towards purchase, renovation, and furnishing of new men's homeless shelter in Csepel.



New Csepel Men's Shelter

 Supplied Red Cross Home for Mothers with Children with 600,000 Ft worth of equipment and furnishings.

Miscellaneous Red Cross Donations

 Donated 160,000 Ft worth of materials and equipment to the Veszprém chapter of the Hungarian Red Cross for the relief of Red Sludge victims in Kolontár and Devecsér.









Donations to the AmCham Foundation

 Donated a total of 2 million Ft to the AmCham Foundation to help fund reconstruction of elementary schools in Devecsér and Kolontár and a kindergarden in Alsózsolca.











Small Grants Program

 Made 380,000 Ft worth of small grants to homeless shelter residents enabling them to rent flats and be reunited with their families.

- Expand school breakfast and afternoon snack program to include an additional five Budapest area schools
- Expand monthly food aid program to Budapest's 10th, 13th and 15th Districts
- Expand daily food aid program to Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén County
- Assist the Hungarian Red Cross upgrade existing homeless shelters and open new ones
- Assist other Hungarian NGOs combat poverty, homelessness and social exclusion




Total Donations to the Hungarian Red Cross in 2010 by Region (89.66 million Ft)


Total Donations to the Hungarian Red Cross by Program in 2010 (89.66 million Ft)


Total AHF Food Donations to the Hungarian Red Cross in 2010: 43.7 million Ft

Total Donations to the AmCham Foundation in 2010 by Fund Drive (2 million Ft)






Planned Donations to the Hungarian Red Cross in 2011 by Region (185 million Ft)
